### **Andrew Young**

Disneyland Hasbeens mourn the passing of Andrew Young, Disneyland Cast Member since 1987. Born January 26, 1969, Andrew grew up in the New York area. He moved to California when he was just eighteen years old to follow his dream of working at Disneyland. It would become his life story, complete with a fairy tale romance. Andrew and fellow Cast Member Jennifer Perry married in the early 1990s, and made it a point to choose Disneyland's birthday, July 17, as their wedding date. Andrew spent the bulk of his Disney career in the Store Operations and Merchandise divisions, and was working as a stock replenishment manager when he died on Wednesday, March 15, 2006. He leaves his wife, Jennifer, and young son Devon. The following information is from Disneyland:
